

Meetings were held where CAPA students and graduates gave advice to their teachers, treaters and supervisors about dealing with patients and supervisees who had quickly switch to Zoom. Because China was so many months ahead of the West in dealing with the pandemic, these discussions were very useful. We, in CAPA, are lucky. The therapeutic world had to learn how to use Zoom. We already knew.

Good News from China

1-Because of the very strict rules which people followed, the epidemic has been almost completely eradicated in China. Schools, restaurants, museums, etc. are open. People can walk about without masks. I just wish that things were going that well here. Please everyone-BE CAREFUL.

2-Members of CIC (CAPAIN CHINA) has organized 3 Mandarin language psychotherapy training programs using the CAPA curriculum which they are translating. The teachers are CAPA advanced training grads (some are distance analytic candidates). CIC has also organized a training program with two 50 person classes for "beginners." The teachers in this program have taken a class in pedagogy-more than the rest of us have done.

NEWS FROM CIC

CIC established a Training Department in 2020 and launched two training programs. The first one, "Train the Trainee," fifty-two CAPA graduates of Advanced Programs, or above, were recruited and chosen to become trainers. Lectures covered teaching techniques, ethics and techniques of group supervision. These were given by experienced trainers who are also CAPA graduates. Presentations of their teaching accompanied, with feedback by four consultants who have become psychoanalytic candidates after finishing CAPA programs.

The second program, "Marching toward 1000 Hours", is a Psychodynamic Psychotherapy Program for beginners whose number of clinical hours is between 100 and 300 hours. The curriculum is modeled after CAPA Basic Program technique class with an addition of one ethics class. Over 120 applications were received and 50 applicants were selected by means of an interview. The two parallel classes, each with 25 students, will commence on October 9 and 10 ends in June 2021. Topics will be supplemented by local chapters who hold public thematic talks, such as psychiatric knowledge for counselors, working with LGBTQ communities. We are looking forward to rewarding results of this program and the birth of new programs in the coming future.
